Street Rodding The Old Fashioned Way



Speaker: **Chris Case**
Automotive Writer



Chris Case has spent a lifetime in the automobile industry. He has been involved in automotive teaching, wholesale and retail sales, and service. His automotive sports involvement includes competition go-carts, dirt track racing, drag racing, tractor and truck pulling, street machines, and street rodding.

In 1995, he began construction of his home-built nostalgia street rod, a 1927 Ford Model T. Starting with a frame design that was engineered with his brother through Envisioneering of Eau Claire, Wisconsin, the first steel tubing was cut during the Christmas season of that year. Over the next several summers, the car progressed into a small block powered street rod. All the parts and components were constructed, modified, rebuilt, or assembled in his garage. No part of the car is from a kit. Even the body is a hand layered fiberglass mat body originally designed for use in Super Comp drag racing.

Chris is currently working as a freelance writer on automotive technical "How To" articles. In addition to writing, he is attending Oakland University working toward a Masters Degree in the Art of Education, specializing in reading, literacy, and teaching.
