Energy: Technologies and Global Outlook

Speaker: Mr. John L. Glardon, Retired Vice President of Akzo Nobel Coatings.

There will be student project displays, and a lecture and discussion on global energy concerns, at 11:00 a.m. The lecture is arranged by the Society of Automotive Engineers, and the Saginaw Valley Engineering Council.

Mr. Glardon's presentation will deal with the following subjects:

1. Greenhouse and toxic gas emissions; global warming.
2. Our dependence on Middle Eastern fossil fuels.
3. Thirteen different sources of energy: costs, benefits, risks, availability, and future potential.
4. Practices in the U.S. and in various foreign countries.
5. Global policies.
