## Father / Son Racing

Greg Mroz joined General Motors in 1980, and has worked in engine dynamometer development and engine durability, vehicle validation, and is presently working for the SPO service group.

He began racing in 1995, racing sprint and endure go-karts at Grattan Race Track in Michigan. He raced go-karts for 2 years, then bought a Fiat 128 in 2001 and raced it in the in the GT5 class in Waterford, MI and Mid Ohio. He won the GT5 championship at Waterford Hills. In 2002 he bought his current car, a 1983 Trans Am, and raced it at the Waterford Hills Road Racing in the GT1 class. He was a driver rep on the competition board at Waterford Hills from 2002 to 2004.
